2 Create a BiblioBoard Account

- When the app opens, you will be taken to a sign in page.
 (If the sign in page does not open, tap the menu icon in the upper right corner of the screen.)
- If you already have a BiblioBoard account, tap on SIGN IN; if you do not, tap Create Yours Now!




NOTE: Creating and signing in with a BiblioBoard account will allow you to save favorite items, add bookmarks and

notes, access your recently viewed content, download books, and sync your preferences across devices.

For new accounts, you will
then be taken to the Create
your profile page. Choose YES
on the left side (the "No, I'll
choose my library" option is
not available for MN Libraries).



- On the next screen, enter your email address (optional), then create a user name and password (typed twice).
- Select the CREATE PROFILE button.



Now you should be signed in and ready to download eBooks.

3 Download eBooks

- First, make sure you are signed into eBooks MN with your user name and password
- To check out a book, click on its cover and then check the offline **Bookshelf** box.



- You should see an Add to Offline Bookshelf? screen.
- Click on Add to download a copy of the book to your device.



4 Accessing your eBooks

 To access downloaded titles, tap the






Home Menu icon in the upper right corner of the

screen.

category and then the
Offline Bookshelf option.
A list of downloaded titles
will appear on the screen.
Click on the book cover to
get options.



- Click on the **READ THIS** button to open the book.
- To remove the downloaded book from your device, uncheck the offline Bookshelf box and it will be deleted.






5 Searching for eBooks

If using a device, open up the BiblioBoard Library app. If you are online, go to **https://library.biblioboard.com** (Note: you must set up an eBooks MN account while using an internet connection within the state of Minnesota to be able to access these books via the internet when traveling outside of the state)

You can search by entering your search terms in the Search BiblioBoard search box in the upper left of the page:



The results of your search will show up below.




6 Browsing eBooks

When you arrive at the website or open the app, you will see **Popular Curations** which will give you some general categories to browse in each section. Scroll down on the screen to see more categories




For other browsing options, click on **Browse By** in the upper right corner and choose either **Categories** or **Modules** from the dropdown menu.



Browse By Category will present the books sorted by the categories/subjects listed. Scroll down and click on a category to browse.



Browse By Module will sort the books by: Adult, Children's, Classics, and Middle Grades. Click a module to browse.
