TOMATO TYPES

• Indeterminate

These continue growing until frost or other conditions kill them Can easily grow 6-8 feet tall They produce fruit throughout the season

Most heirloom tomatoes are indeterminate.

• Determinate

These grow to a certain size and stop growing They tend to set all their fruit within couple of weeks Many hybrids are determinates

• Dwarf

Not as many options. These are more recently developed for the market

TRELLISING


Determinate and Dwarf tomatoes can be adequately supported with a wire cage Indeterminate tomatoes need much more support!

Heavy-duty cages with stakes



HARDENING OFF YOUR SEEDLINGS



Gradually introduce your young plants to the outside.

They need to be acclimated to the sun and the wind.

This is traditionally done by moving them outside and back inside each day. This can be difficult if you work away from home.

Can use shady spots around your home or various shadecloths.



SITE AND PLANTING

- Full sun location (6 hours/day min.)
- Well-drained soil, amended with compost
- Well-balanced organic fertilizer
- Remove lower leaves
- Plant deeply, right up to the leaves
- Water in well
- Water daily for 7–10 days
