

## REQUEST A BOOKMOBILE STOP

Thank you for your interest in bookmobile services for your neighborhood or school. The Bookmobile is a traveling branch of the Rochester Public Library and provides services throughout Olmsted County. The Bookmobile has three schedules a year:

**Fall** (September - December); **Winter/Spring** (January - May); **Summer** (June - August).

When creating a Bookmobile schedule, we target areas to members of the community who are unable to use the main library due to geographic, transportation, economic or other barriers. All Rochester Public Library Bookmobile stops – including stops at schools and other institutions – are open to the public.

We currently have a full schedule of Bookmobile stops, so adding more stops would potentially require removing others. To add a new stop, we have the following requirements:

- A minimum of 35 combined checkouts at each visit
- Commitment of support from your school, neighborhood, or organization
- A completed Bookmobile Stop petition
- Approval by the Bookmobile planning team

Submitting a petition does not guarantee that your request will be granted. Petitions must be received by the following dates to be considered for the respective schedule:

<b>June 15</b>	Fall
<b>Oct. 15</b>	Winter/Spring
<b>Feb. 15</b>	Summer
