FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES 2023 MONDAY, JANUARY 30, 2023

Val Kaliszewski called the meeting to order at 11:45am and welcomed everyone and thanked everyone: Lynn Wong for the food; the events committee for their work; Jeremiah Baumann, staff; Nicole, graphics designer, Marillyn Campbell, staff. She introduced the board members and thanked the retiring members. She recognized Brenda Kardock, Executive director of the Foundation Board, Nick Goetzfridt, Library Board of Trustees, Karen Lemke, Director of the Library, Kim Edson, speaker. There were 54 in attendance.

The minutes of the 2020 meeting were approved and Dee Voldal gave the Treasurer's report. Income was \$89,551 and expenses were \$56,456. The 2023 Budget was presented and the report was placed on file.

Kay Aune gave the revised bylaws report and the committee moved to adopt the new bylaws. A vote was taken and it passed.

Vice President Phyllis Berman presented the election slate of officers. Being elected for another term were Dee Voldal, Val Kaliszewski, and Ann Griese. New board members were Jim McMullin, Caroline Baihly, and Deb Pluth. The slate was accepted by the members in attendance.

The 2022 year in review was given with volunteer statistics given by Marilyn Campbell and Val giving information on donations and additions to the library collection, auditorium sales, online sales, etc.

Sandy George presented a check to Karen Lemke for \$65,000 from bookstore proceeds from 2022. Karen Lemke accepted the check with thanks and praise for all the Friends members for all of their hard work.
